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## WELCOME TO GREENENTRE4DEAF

An initiative that combines inclusion, sustainability and technology to create real learning and entrepreneurship opportunities for deaf and hearing impaired people. This project was created with the aim of transforming higher education through innovative

and accesible methodologies that enable everyone to acquire key competences in the field of green entrepreneurship, aligned with the values of the European Green Pact and the EU Skills Agenda. ## TO WHOM IS IT ADDRESSED?

This project is aimed at higher education students who are deaf or hearing impaired, educators trainers and sign language interpreters, NGOs, associations of deaf people, public authorities, SME companies and labour market actors.

## PROJECT OBJECTIVES

GREENENTRE4DEAF aims to transform the way green entrepreneurship is taught at university level, ensuring equitable access to lifelong learning opportunities. The main objectives of the project include :

- ✓ Design an accredited modular programme in green entrepreneurship, adapted to students who are deaf or have hearing loss.
- ✓ Create an inclusive European Green Entrepreneurship Competence Framework, accompanied by sign language resources.
- ✓ Develop a mobile application to support entrepreneurship for students and future DHH (Deaf and Hard of Hearing) professionals.
- ✓ Implement virtual reality (VR) simulations depicting green professions in inclusive and accessible environments.
- ✓ Establish Living Hubs in universities and partner centres as permanent spaces for inclusive training and career guidance.
