

# Survey results of 2022 graduates studying in English

## 1. General information

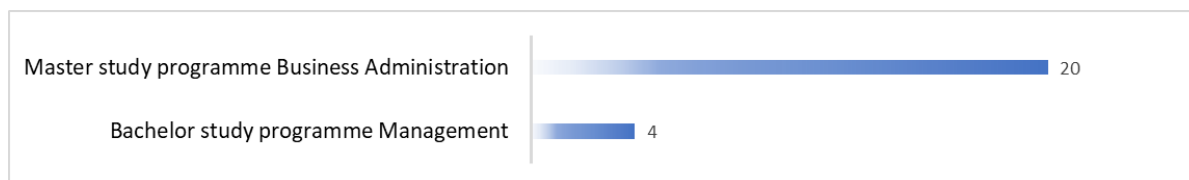


Fig. 1. Number of respondents by study programme

A total of 24 respondents from 2 study programmes participated in the graduate survey. The distribution of the number of respondents by study programme is given in Figure 1.

### Proportion of respondents from the number of graduates in programmes:

- ✓ Bachelor study programme Management – 67% (4 out of 6)
- ✓ Master study programme Business Administration – 95% (20 no 21)

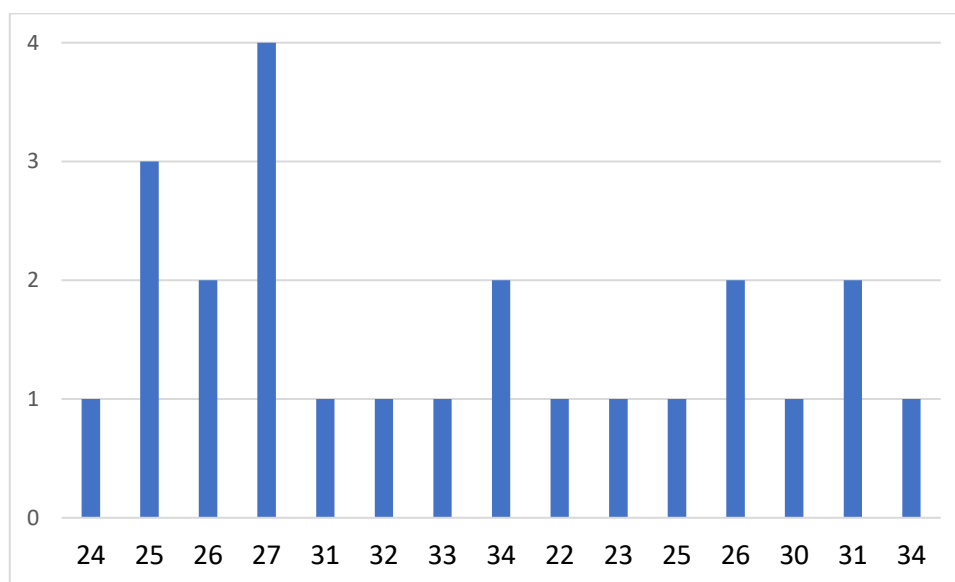


Fig. 2. Age distribution of respondents

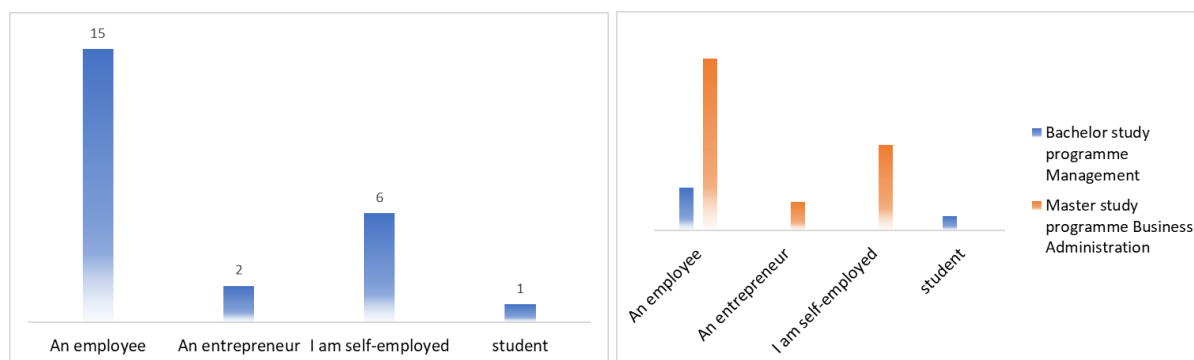


Fig. 3. Type of occupation of respondents at the time of the survey.

The answers to the question of the current occupation are divided into basic groups and given in Figure 3.

## 2. Assessment of various aspects of the study programme.

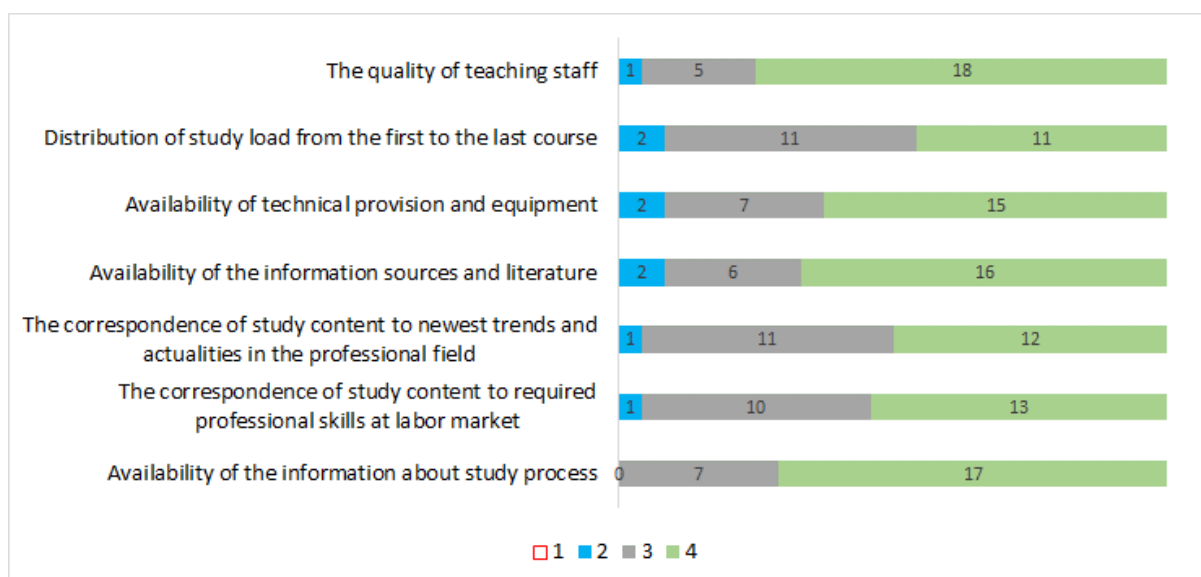


Fig. 4. Satisfaction with various aspects of the study programme

When asked (question 3) about satisfaction with different aspects of the study programme on a scale from 1 to 4, where 1 - bad, 2 - satisfactory, 3 - good, 4 - very good, respondents replied as follows (see Figure 4):

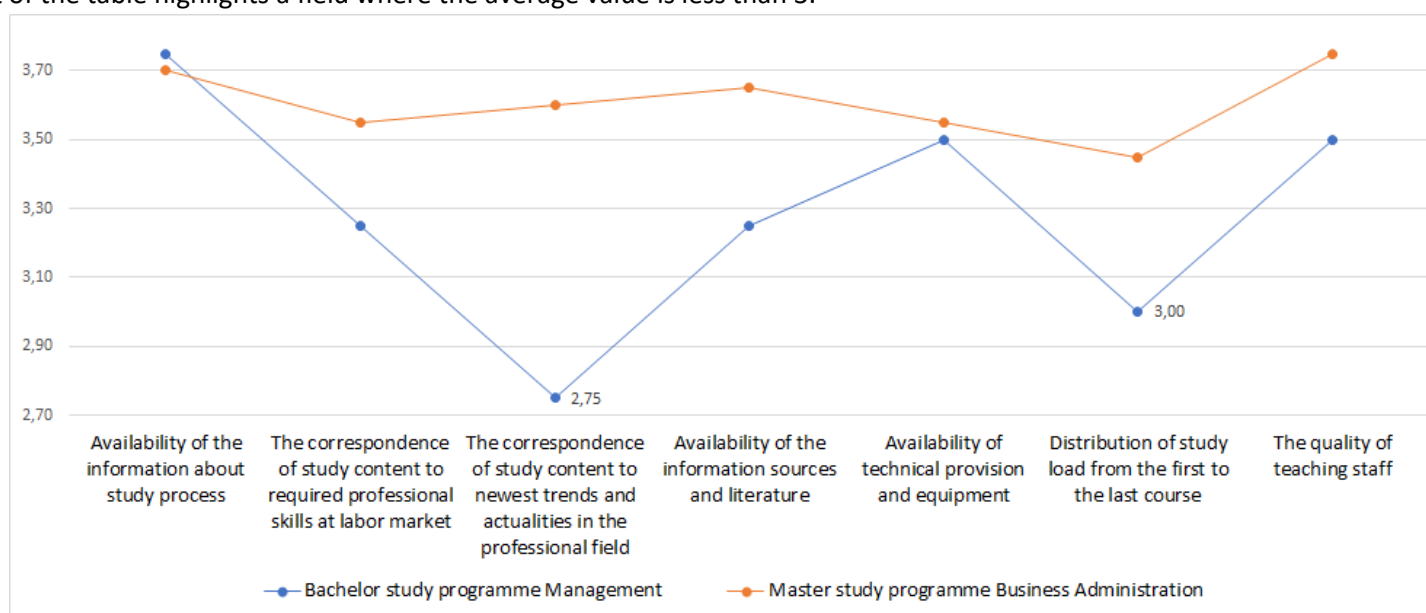


Fig. 5. Average evaluations of the graduate survey by aspects of the study process and study programmes

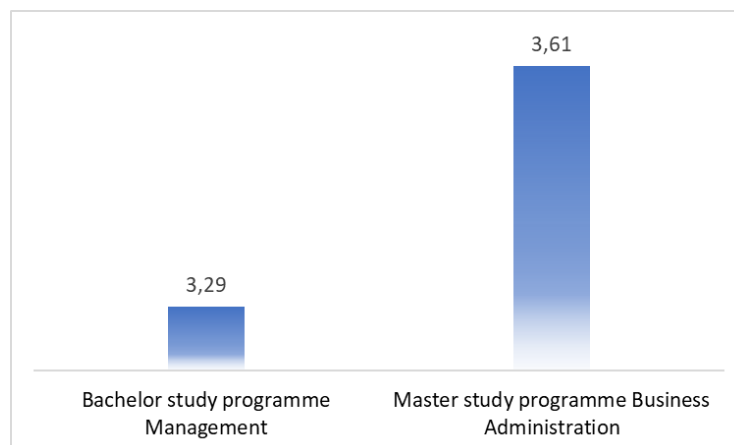


Fig. 6. Average assessment of the overall study aspects by study programme

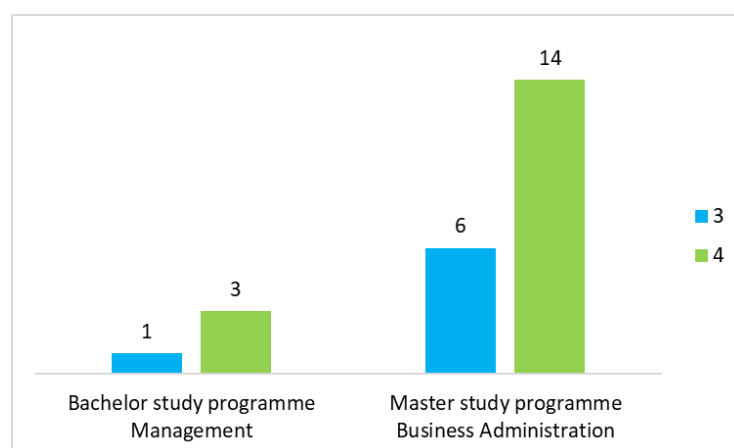


Fig. 7. Assessment of the availability of information about the study process

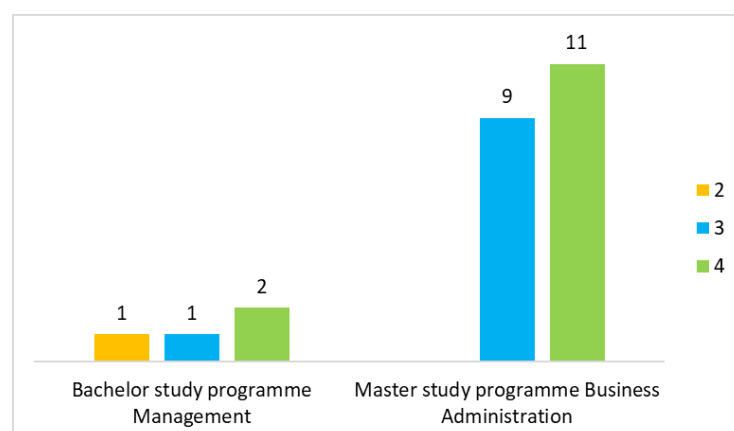


Fig. 8. Compliance of the study content with the knowledge required in the field

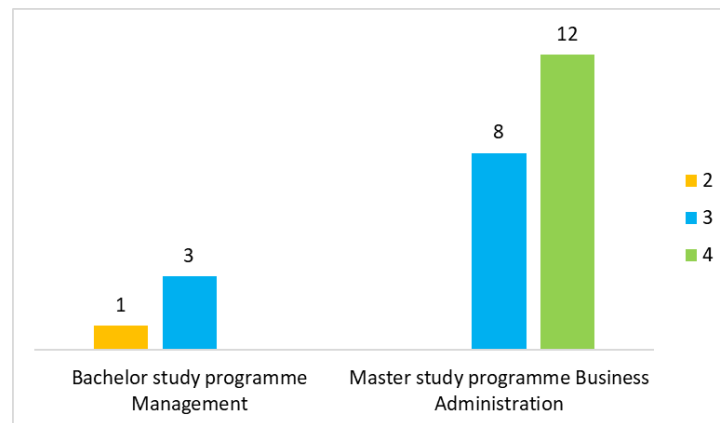


Fig. 9. Compliance of study content with the latest trends in the industry

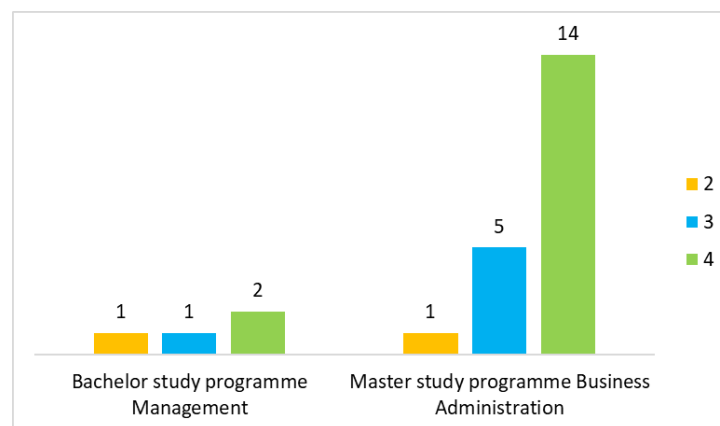


Fig. 10. Availability of the necessary literature and information resources

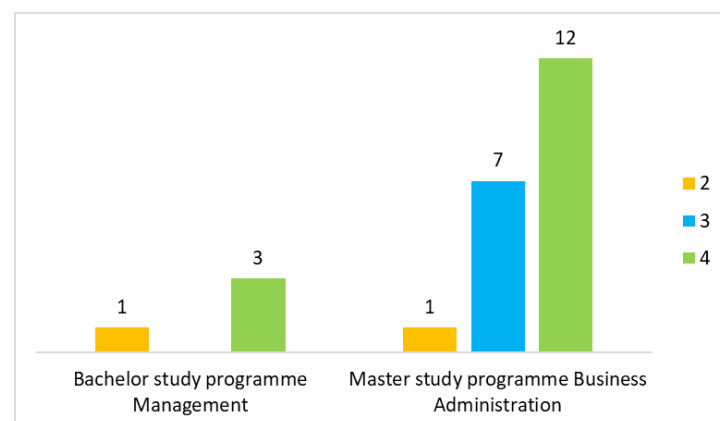


Fig. 11. Availability of technical equipment

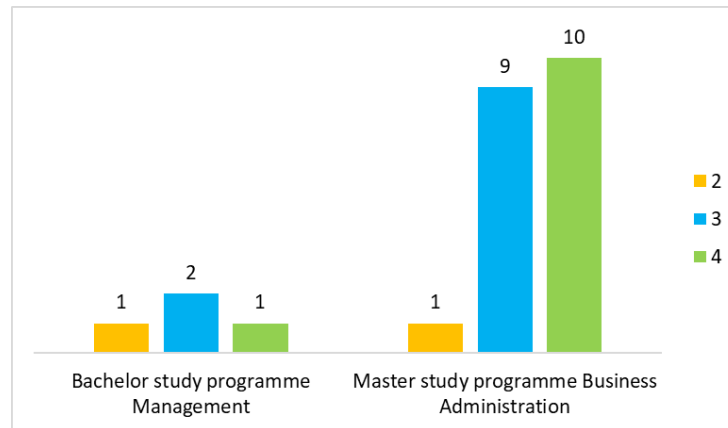


Fig. 12. Distribution of study load from the first to the last year

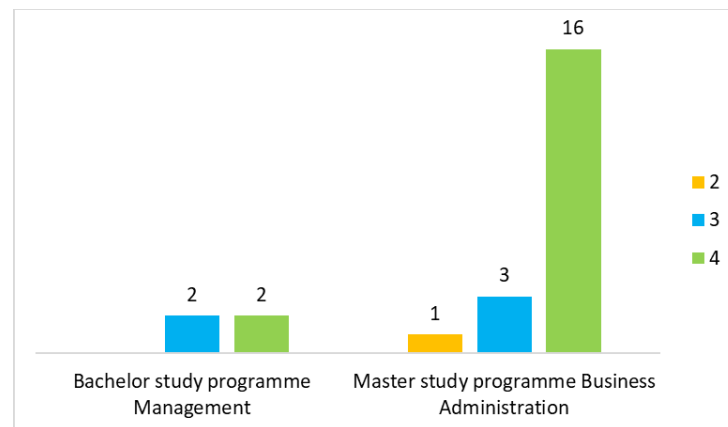


Fig. 13. The quality of the work of the teaching staff

### 3. Do you use the knowledge gained during your studies in your daily work?

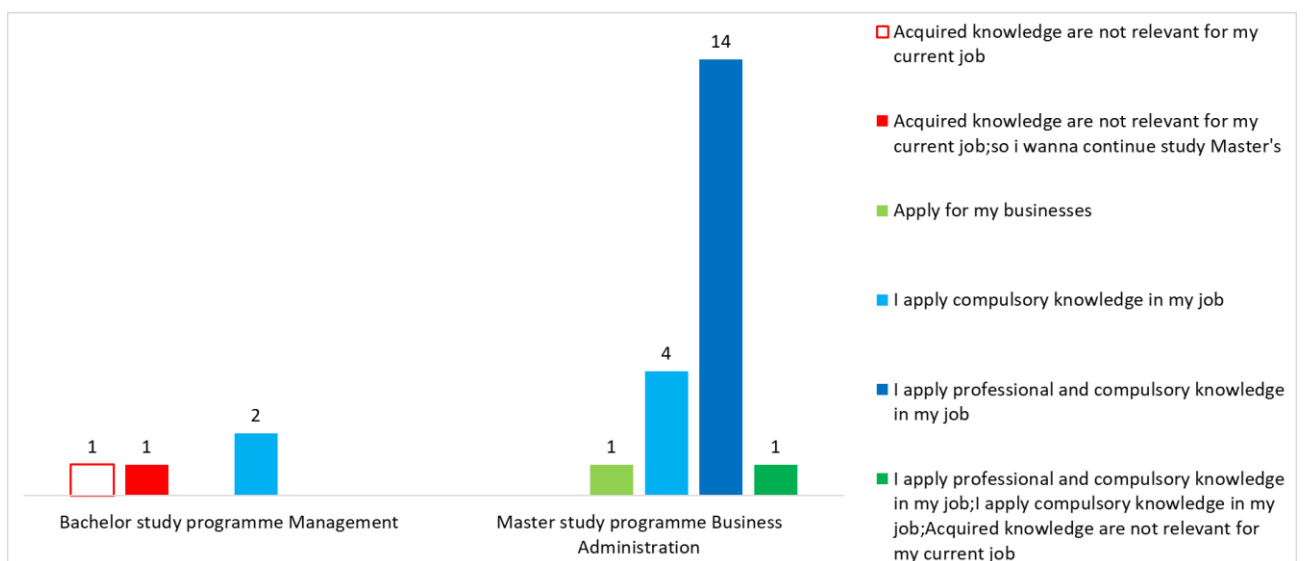


Fig. 14. Assessment of the knowledge acquired during studies by study programme.

#### 4. How has the education you received affected your professional development?

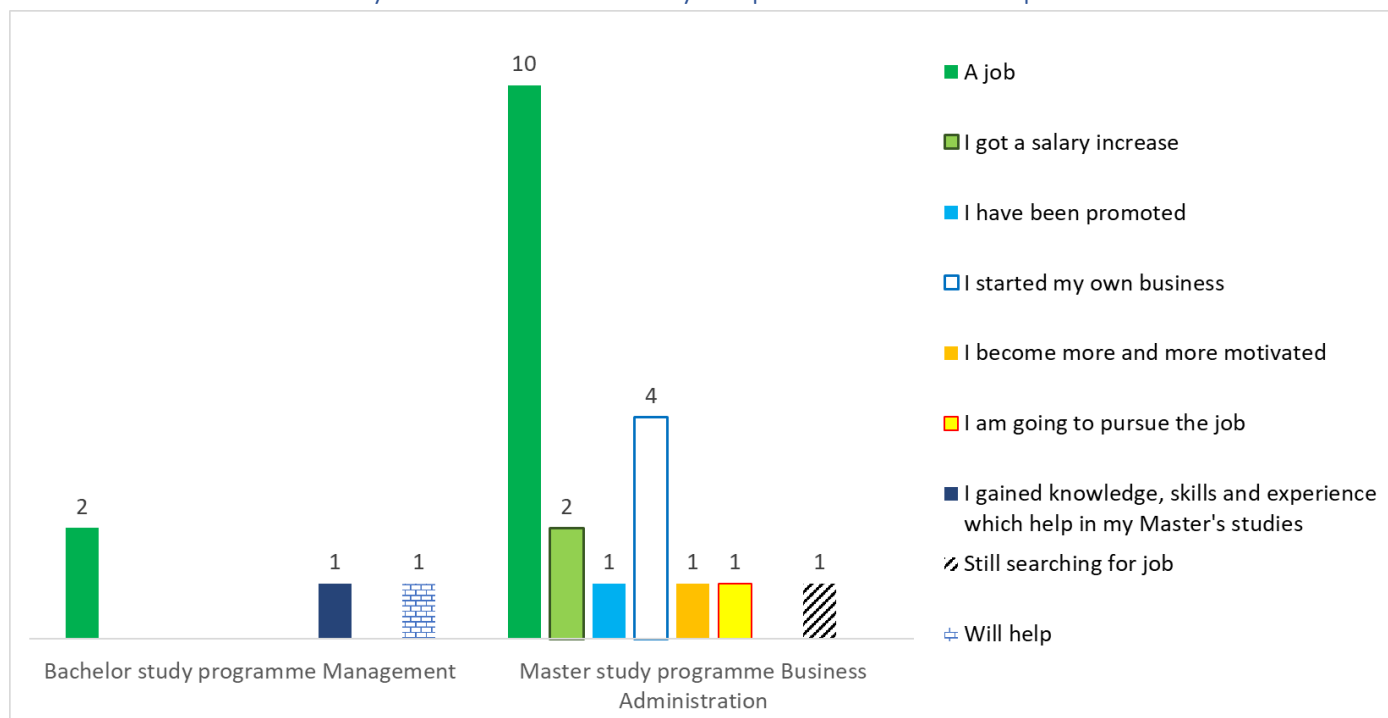


Fig. 15. Assessment of professional development by study programme.

#### 5. Do you plan to continue your studies at the next level of education?

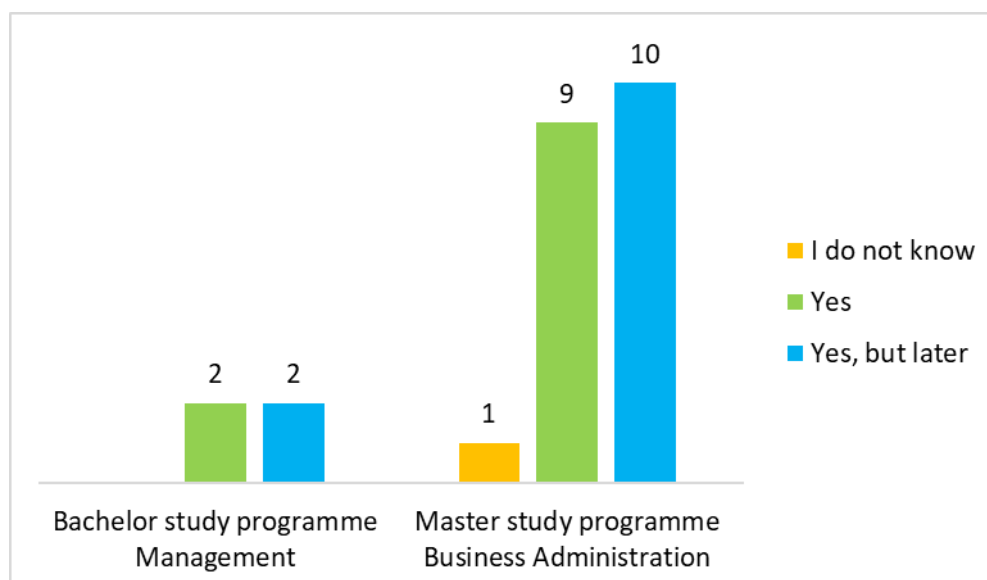


Fig. 16. Graduates' opinion on the continuation of studies at the next level of education by study programme.

6. Would you recommend studying in the study programme for relatives, friends or acquaintances?

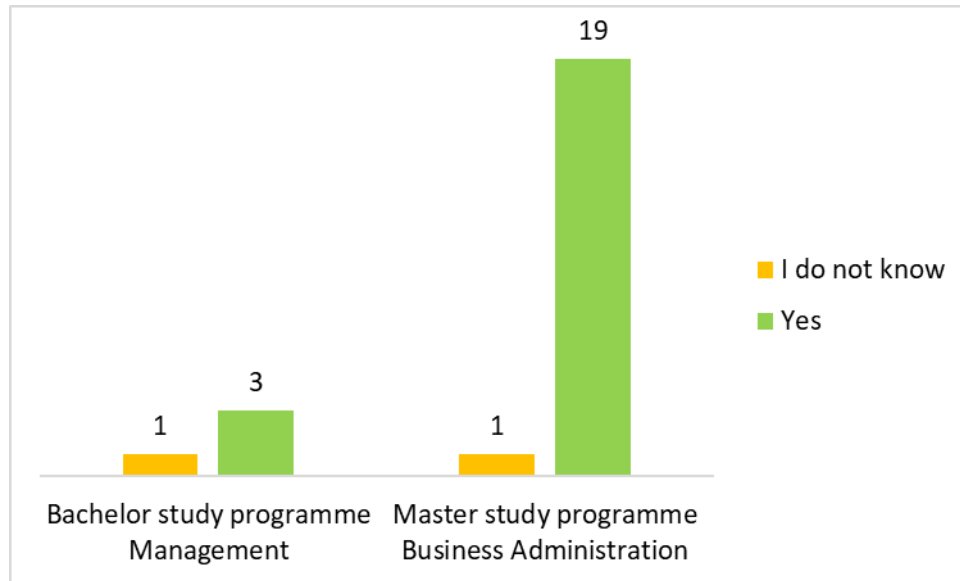


Fig. 17. Graduates' opinion on recommending studies to study in the study program to relatives, friends or acquaintances.
